## **Weekly Tasks**

### **Takeaway Grid**

This grid is linked to our English, History and Science work. When possible, work should be completed in this book. If this is not appropriate e.g. when a model has been made or when work has been completed electronically please make a note in the book of the task that has been completed.

### **Handing in work**

This book should be handed in by Thursday of each week. Feedback will be given on tasks, this may be written or verbal. As stated on the grid, in some cases children will be expected to share their work with the class. Homework books will be returned to the children on a Friday.

## **Ongoing tasks throughout the year**

### **Maths Key Skills Grid**

We will be covering lots of different concepts throughout the year. The grid has some key skills that we need to develop by the end of Year 4 with a 'little and often' approach. The grid gives examples of how to rehearse the skill as well as links to interactive games or printable sheets. Any comments or maths tasks can be written in this book although this is not essential.

### **Spelling**

As you will be aware, we are focusing on key word spellings in Year 4. These words should be spelt correctly in all homework tasks. Children may also benefit from specific spelling support at home with words from either the key word list or the Year 3/4 statutory words list. Again, any comments or spelling work in the homework book is welcome but not essential.

### **Reading**

Reading remains the most essential skill in primary school. Children are expected to read aloud to an adult at least 4 times per week. Where a child is a very fluent reader, please focus more on discussing texts that have been read independently. Reading records will be checked separately on a Monday.
