## Choose your homework from the menu below:

*Tutankhamen suggests the challenge or difficulty of each task (legs - least challenging, mask - most challenging)*

- Every term you should attempt at least one 'MASK' task, you can have 2 weeks for this!



Mask

Create a mini-project about the River Nile. Include: its length, its depth, where its source is, which sea it flows into, which countries it passes through, important events in history that have happened near or on the river.  
You will be expected to talk to the class about your work

Make a model of the human digestive system and explain the job of each organ.  
You will be expected to talk to the class about your work

Research what homes in Ancient Egypt were like. Create a model to show either the house or an item that would be found inside the house. Make sure that you can explain, in detail what you have made!  
You will be expected to talk to the class about your work

Lungs

How did they pay for things in Ancient Egypt? Carry out some research and present your information as a fact-file or poster.

Research the Ancient Egyptian number system and come up with number sentences and answers. Use a variety of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

Write your own short story based on The Promise. Try to include a key message within your work.

Intestines

What is the difference between carnivores, herbivores and omnivores? Investigate examples of each type of animal and present the information in any way you choose.

Write a description of an urban setting. You should describe the city as either negative and unwelcoming or positive and inviting

Create a map of Ancient Egypt, placing significant landmarks on, for example, the Nile, the pyramids, The Valley of the Kings.

Legs

Write an acrostic poem based on Ancient Egypt

Draw and label the different types of teeth. What is the job of each one?

Design your own Ancient Egyptian flag.
