- Every term you should attempt at least one 'EXTRA HOT' task, you can have 2 weeks for this!



Write a newspaper report about the Roman invasion of Britain. This could be from the point of view of anyone living in Roman times. Think carefully about what is being reported.

Make a fact file/presentation about an animal of your choice. Include information about their habitat and what they eat.

Build a 3D model of an item from Roman times (e.g. villa, temple, armour, shield, pottery, jewellery). Make sure you can explain what it is and what it would have been used for.

Create a crossword with keywords from our science or history topic. Write a definition of each keyword as a clue. Have a look at crosswords to see how they work.

Create a fact sheet about Roman Gods. Make sure you include detailed information about them.

Create a timeline of events in Roman times. What are the key dates that need to be included? Make sure you include dates for Roman invasions.

Learn how to write Roman numerals. Create your own maths calculations using these.

Write 5 addition/subtraction word problems of your own. Try a two-step question if you can. Make sure you have an answer sheet too!

Re-tell a story which involves a miracle (either from our RE lessons of one of your own). You can act it out and take photos, make a comic strip or any other ideas you have.

The Romans conquered lots of countries. Draw the flags of at least 3 of these countries. Are there any other facts that you know about the Romans and these countries?

Design a poster that will help you to remember some of the times tables that you are not sure about.

Create a 10 question quiz about the Romans. Make sure that you know the answers too!
