## **Topic**

In Year Two the children will continue to follow a topic-based curriculum. This term our topic will be London. We will be finding out all about our capital city and learning about some of the events that have shaped it over the course of time, particularly the Great Fire of London.

Our English work will involve reading a range of fiction and non-fiction texts, including reports and leaflets about London, picture books with a London theme or setting, stories such as Paddington Bear, and poems. Theses texts will also provide inspiration for our writing.

Our whole school focus in Geography is 'How has our local area changed over time?' As part of this we will be going on a walk round the village and finding out all about what the village used to look like.

We will put a copy of our topic web and timetable on the class blog at the start of each new topic so you can find out more about what your child will be learning.

# Reading and Phonics

The teaching of reading is a combined effort between child, teacher, parents and TAs. All children participate in guided reading sessions each week and through these sessions we are able to assess

Book change will take place on a Thursday or Friday. The children will be given several books each week - please let us know if you need more.

Phonics/spelling

The children will continue to have discrete spelling and phonics sessions in class. We will be sending home a list of common exception words (common words that can be tricky to

spell) in book bags soon. We would appreciate it if you could help your child practise spelling these words at home, particularly when they are completing homework tasks. More information about homework will follow shortly.

#### Maths

In Maths we will be using lots of apparatus to learn in a practical way. We will also learn how to show our working out using pictorial representations, such as the bar model and the part whole model. The objectives we will be focussing on are:

- \*Use place value and number facts to solve problems
- \*Compare and order numbers from 0-100; use < > and =
- \*Solve problems with addition and subtraction involving numbers, quantities and measures.
- \*Apply knowledge of mental and written methods when solving addition and subtraction problems.
- \*Recall and use addition and subtraction facts to 100.
- \* Recognise and use inverse operations to check calculations

#### Science

In science we will be investigating different materials, looking in particular at what houses were made from, both before and after The Great Fire of London. We will also be looking at reversible and irreversible changes that occur when different materials are heated or cooled.

#### ICT

In our ICT session we will be giving directions to probots to get them to draw certain shapes or to move in certain pathways. Later in the term we will be using sound recorders to create Fire of London soundscapes.

#### P.E

Both of our P.E sessions will take place on Wednesdays. Whilst the weather is dry at least one of these sessions will be outdoors so please make sure your child has suitable outdoor P.E kit to wear.

If you are able to spare any time, we are always very grateful for any parent help in the classroom so please do let us know. Finally, if you would like to discuss anything concerning your child please do not hesitate to make an appointment to see us.
